Quality Improvement Supervisor

Reporting to our Quality Control Manager, you will work as part of a small team to ensure that quality standards are upheld during the production process and the quality of the end products meet EN and BSI standards as well as matching the specifications provided by our customers. Your remit will be initially to monitor and identify areas that require improvement to reduce the level of internal reworks. This constitutes daily reporting of specific nonconformance to the department supervisors with supporting corrective actions to ensure immediate and sustained improvement. You will prepare a daily report detailing observations, actions and outcomes.

Once sustained improvements have been attained the role will encompass providing training of existing and new employees along with creating updated training records and relevant internal quality checks and measures.

Applicants must be approachable but strong willed as they will be required to highlight operators effect on poor quality of work, however the applicant will also feedback the improvements and benefits to all. It is essential that you have a minimum of 2 years quality/training experience working within a manufacturing environment. Candidates with no relevant experience will not be considered. As well as strong communication skills both verbal and written, you should also have excellent attention to detail, be conscientious in approach to all tasks, dedicated and professional about maintaining the highest quality standards.

Hours of work will be Monday to Friday 6am to 2pm alternating weekly with a 2pm to 10.30pm Monday to Thursday and Friday 2pm to 8pm shift (37.5hours paid weekly). Rate of pay will be dependent upon experience.
